**SAFEGUARDING:** Following on from the Down and Connor Diocese Pathways to the Future Programme, we are pleased to announce the establishment of the Downpatrick Family of Parishes Safeguarding Committee. The Committee will comprise representatives from Downpatrick Parish, the Parish of Saul and Bailee, the Parish of Bright, the Parish of Dunsford and Ardglass and the Parish of Kilclief (Strangford). Mrs Patricia Magee (Mobile 07855 928241) will Chair the Committee, Mrs Karen Curran (Mobile 07803 270100) is Deputy Chair and Fr Aidan Brankin will be the Parish Priest on the Committee. The primary role of the Downpatrick Family of Parishes Safeguarding Committee is to: 1.Ensure that Diocesan Safeguarding Policies and Procedures are implemented. 2. Identify the activities within a Parish in which children and adults at risk are involved. This includes non-Parish groups, using Parish premises, who must state that they have appropriate safeguarding measures in place. 3. Ensure that volunteers working with children, young people and adults at risk, are safely recruited, vetted and trained in accordance with Down and Connor Safeguarding procedures and adhere to a Code of Conduct.

**\*\*Could This Be You? \*\*** With the arrival and induction of a new bishop (Bishop McGuckian, began in Down and Connor in April) the committees and various councils of the diocese must be renewed. This is taking place on a diocesan level. This also applies to similar bodies within parishes. Our current Parish Pastoral Council has served the parish for several years.
